# PRABHU DAYAL PUBLIC SCHOOL Promotion Policy for Classes IX and XI SESSION 2022-23 

## 1. Promotion Rules For Class IX:

(a) Promotion to the next higher class shall be decided on the basis of the cumulative result of the average marks of two periodic tests (05 marks), Multiple Assessment (05 marks), Portfolio (05 marks), Subject Enrichment Activities (05 Marks), Mid term Exam and Annual Examination as per the circular no. DE.5/212/Exam/16-17/Part-1/365-374 issued by Directorate of Education dated 01.07.2022.
(b) In order to be declared "Pass", a student must secure at least $33 \%$ marks out of 100 \{Internal Assessment (20 marks) and External Assessment ( 80 marks) \} in each of the five main subjects.
(c) In order to be declared pass in the skill course subject, a student has to secure $33 \%$ marks in practical and theory exam separately.
(d) A student will be eligible to appear for compartment examination in not more than two failing subjects.
(e)The Compartment Examination will be conducted on the same pattern as of Annual examination.
(f) In order to be declared "Successful" in Compartment Examination, a student must secure at least $33 \%$ marks in the subject(s) in which he/she has given the Compartment Examination.
(g)A student of Class IX who is not eligible for Pass, Promotion or Compartment Examination shall be declared FAIL and detained in the same class during the next session.

## 2. Promotion Rules For Class XI:

(a) Promotion to the next higher class shall be decided on the basis of the cumulative result of Mid term Exam and Annual Examination as per the circular no. DE.5/212/Exam/16-17/Part-1/365-374 issued by Directorate of Education dated 01.07.2022.
(b) In order to be declared "Pass" at the end of the session, a student must secure at least $33 \%$ marks in each of the five main subjects.
(c) He She must secure $33 \%$ marks separately in theory and in practical/Internal Assessment.
(d) A student will be eligible to appear for compartment examination in only one failing subject.
(e) The Compartment Examination will be conducted on the same pattern as of Annual examination.
(f) In order to be declared "Successful" in Compartment Examination, a student must secure at least $33 \%$ marks in the subject in which he/she has taken the Compartment Examination. The promotion is also subject to the condition that he/she secures 33\% marks separately in Practical/ Internal assessment also.
(g) A student of Class XI who is not eligible for Pass, Promotion or Compartment Examination shall be declared FAIL and detained in the same class during the next session.
