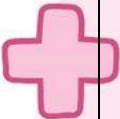
Summer Homework: Where Learning Meets Adventure!

$$\angle A = (2x + 4)^\circ, \quad \angle B = (2x - 13)^\circ,$$

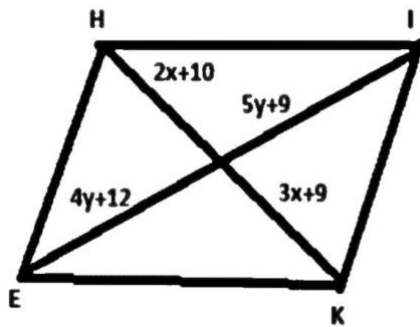

7. Write any 2 properties of a square and a rhombus.

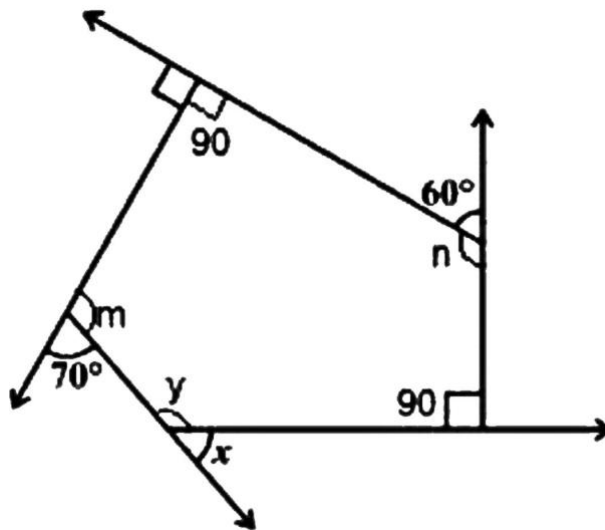
8. Find the measure of all 4 angles of a parallelogram whose consecutive angles are in the ratio 1:3.
